Who says house calls are a thing of the past?

At Ferris Hills at West Lake, residents can now receive on-site medical care through the UR Medicine Geriatrics Group. Affiliated with the University of Rochester Medical Center, the group offers comprehensive services including routine physical exams, acute sick visits and mobile x-rays. If a resident needs to see a specialist, the group's physicians, nurse practitioners and physician assistants – all of whom are specially trained in the care of older adults – can also provide referrals. "Because they provide care to residents right where they live, they can discuss diagnosis and treatment plans in a more relaxed and private environment," notes

Jennifer Army, a licensed practical nurse who serves as program manager for Ferris Hills' enriched living community, Clark Meadows.

Not having to worry about transportation, parking or weather means convenience for residents, but Jennifer says the service is especially appreciated by residents who are new to the area and may be having trouble finding a primary care physician who is taking new patients.

All major insurances are accepted by the UR Medicine Geriatrics Group,

which first began offering services at Clark Meadows on Dec. 12 and will start at Ferris Hills in January, with routine visits from Dr. Leslie Myers and Nurse Practitioner Elisa Elliott. With an on-call service for unexpected medical needs, they and their colleagues are available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

As needed, patients receive expedited care at URMC urgent care facilities, and, should circumstances require, are admitted to F.F. Thompson Hospital, Strong Memorial Hospital or Highland Hospital.
