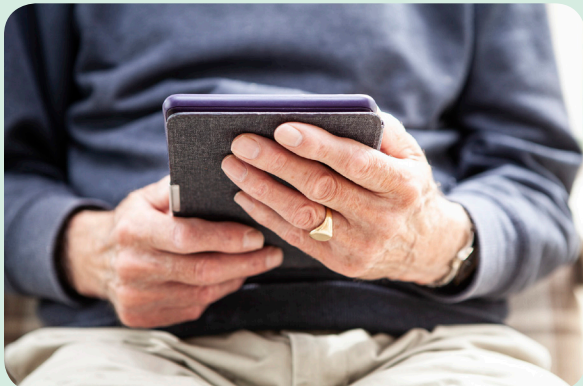
Ferris Hills Adds Kindles to Library
